Year One Confirmation Retreat

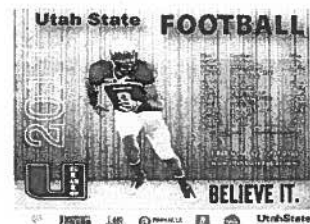

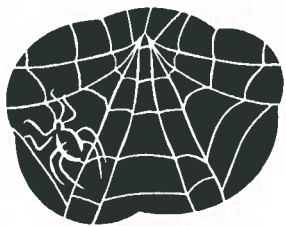

OCTOBER IS NATIONAL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AWARENESS MONTH

In observance of National Domestic Violence Awareness Month, our community service project will benefit the Honolulu Domestic Violence Shelter. Donations will be collected throughout the month of October., Please see the ushers before or after Mass, or you may drop off your donations at the Rectory Office.

The Child and Family Service program was established in the 1980s to serve all domestic violence victims on the island of Oahu. The Shelter is staffed 24/7 with a 24/7 hotline that is always answered.

The 24 hour/7days a week hotline number is 841-0822

The Shelter has a no turn away policy regardless of how crowded they are. Service provided includes: safety and safety planning, Domestic Violence groups, one-on-one counseling, food, clothing, toiletries, diapers, referrals to all needed services, help with housing, and transportation. Services for children, as well as school supplies, toys and other needs are also provided.

SHELTER WISH LIST

Toiletries: Shampoo, conditioner, soap, tooth paste and brushes (travel size preferred); deodorant, make-up, nail polish and polish remover, manicure sets, combs, brushes and accessories and feminine hygiene items (pads and tampons).

Clothing: Women's and children's clothing (used is fine); New underwear for women and children; bras (used okay); diapers, size 3 and up including pull-ups.

Towels and Bedding: Face cloths, towels, bath mats (used is fine); sheets, pillow cases, light weight blankets, bed pillows (used is fine); futons, for when we have more clients than beds.

Kitchen: Small appliances (used is fine), plates, bowls, silverware, plastic glasses, coffee cups, pots and pans.

Other: Writing journals, black ink pens, table top fans, non-perishable food, umbrellas; store gift cards to be used for client birthdays and Christmas gifts; and ***monetary donations are always welcome!***
